She is currently attending Villanova University to become a Department Of Justice accredited representative and assist veterans in legal deportation proceedings. Diane is currently serving as a Board Member with Repatriate Our Patriots and has actively been working on researching and consolidating data on Deported Veterans. She is an active member of the organization and her role expands to veteran case work, financial and medical aid coordination, evaluation and assessment of veteran housing and environmental living conditions.
